



## ***Vermont Emergency Management EOC Operations Course***

Vermont Emergency Management will be conducting the newly developed *EOC Operations Course* program on Thursday, April 16<sup>th</sup> from 6-9pm at the Kirk Alumni Center on the Middlebury College Campus. This is the second of several offerings of this course throughout Vermont

This course examines the role, design, and functions of Emergency Operations Centers (EOC) and their relationships as components of a multi-agency coordination system. The course provides training about staffing and organization, information, systems, communications and equipment needs at the EOC; activating and deactivating the EOC; EOC operations; and EOC testing, training and exercising. It uses activities and case studies about EOCs and multi-agency coordination systems at the local, State and Federal levels of government. This course reflects elements of the FEMA G775 EOC Management and Operations Program.

Municipal Emergency Management Directors and their associates from Fire, Rescue, Law Enforcement, Select boards, and elsewhere are invited to attend and expand their knowledge of emergency management.
